








Full road closure on Harbet Road

Advanced notice: diversion incoming for strategic infrastructure works.



- As part of our ongoing strategic infrastructure works at Meridian Water, we will shortly be closing access for traffic through Harbet Road. A diversion will be in place whilst there is a full road closure.
- Access to Rivermead Road (off Harbet Road), will require drivers to navigate from Crooked Billet roundabout (off the A406). Drivers will not be able to access Rivermead Road, from the Cooks Ferry Roundabout (Southbound).

Late July 2025 to February 2026

- A pedestrian footpath will be maintained throughout these works.
- Health and safety for all, is always our number one priority.

March 2025 to March 2026


- Traffic management is required as we progress with improving the flood alleviation in the area and the widening of Harbet Road, including the installation of new bus stops.
- To reduce the risk of flooding, we are installing new twinned culvert structures under the road, connecting the new flood conveyance channel to Edmonton Marshes.

Phase 1 - 1 lane closure

Current to July 2025

Harbet Road is currently under a 1 lane closure northbound with traffic light management in place.

We are diverting utilities to enable the installation of the culverts, as well as commencing street works.

Phase 2 - full closure

July 2025 to February 2026

Both northbound and southbound lanes closed, with diversion in place for duration.

During this time, we will be installing the new culverts and constructing road improvements. This will include new footpaths and new bus stops on the road.


A raised plaza will be constructed to form a new viewing platform looking out across Edmonton Marshes.



February 2026 to March 2026

As works near completion, we will deliver the hard and soft landscaping elements.

To do this, we will revert back to a 1 lane closure with light traffic management on Harbet Road.
